

After the Interview

Congratulations, you successfully completed an interview! For some of you, it may have been your first one. For others, you've been through another interview before. Whatever the case may be, take a few minutes and reflect on what you just experienced. Think through the questions you were asked and how you answered them.

- Was there any question you didn't understand?
- Did you stumble over an answer you weren't sure about?
- Were you able to talk about your skills and abilities for this job as you expected?

Write out as many of the interview questions you were asked that you can remember. This can be a great resource for you if the employer has any follow up questions. It also can help with future interviews and it can be a confidence booster to remember how you interviewed.

Now that you are done with the interview, here are some next steps:

1. Contact your Talent Advisor and tell them how your interview went.
 - They may have received feedback from the employer, which they can pass along to you. Your Talent Advisor will also contact the employer on your behalf to touch base and gauge the company's interest in you.
2. Anticipate hearing from your Talent Advisor about the placement.
 - If you are accepted for the internship placement, your Talent Advisor will give you information about the next steps.
 - If you are not selected for the internship placement, work with your Talent Advisor for other Internship opportunities that are of your skillset.
